Sale Terms & Conditions

CARSON'S AUCTION SERVICE & WORLD CLYDESDALE SHOW COMMITTEE ACTS AS A SALES AGENT ONLY & ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY AS TO GUARANTEES OF SOUNDNESS, BREEDING CONTRACTS OR STATEMENTS MADE BY CONSIGNOR. ANY VERBALL ANNOUNCEMENTS MADE DAY SALE TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER ANY PREVIOUSLY PRINTED MATTER.

- Entry Fee \$250.00 Flat fee per horse. Entry money can be paid in USA or Canadian Funds and must accompany entry form. Maximum of 30 head – Minimum of 10 head. ENTRY DEADLINE September 1st or until our quota has been met. If an entered consignor needs to make a substitute an additional fee of \$150.00 will be charged. Any animal entered and advertised for sale and are a no show for whatever reason will be charged an additional \$250.00
- All horses must go through the sale ring. ABSOLUTELY NO PRIVATE SALES!
- Horse specifications – Horse must be entered in the show and must be shown in their respective classes even after the animal is sold. Consignors must care for their sale horses throughout the show, but it is suggested that the new buyers immediately insures their animals and an insurance agent will be on site to take care of your needs.
- Each animal must have an individual Coggins paper and interstate health paper which will also be required for the show.
- If an entry is registered the registration paper, signed transfer and if applicable breeding information must be supplied on sale date. It is the sole responsibility of the consignor to furnish these papers. Payment will not be issued until such papers are turned over to Carson's office staff. Bred mares must have a preg. check letter from their vet within 30 days of sale date.
- Each horse selling must be left with a halter & lead rope for the new owner. It is the consignor's responsibility to have the horse up to the ring in sale order.
- Sale payouts will be made within 10 working days of the sale, and will be made in US Funds.
- Individual and special advertising of your horse will be done for an extra \$50.00 – pictures to be supplied.
- The sale order will be determined by the sales management and where possible the horses will sell in catalogue order.
- Terms of the sale are cash or cheque in either USA or Canadian Funds at this time, but a rate may be established depending on the USA & Canadian dollar closer to sale date, and payment in full must be made immediately after the sale. A cheque is acceptable from properly identified individuals. We accept Visa, MasterCard or debit. However, a 4% charge will be added to all credit card purchases. Pay the sales staff in all cases. On final payment for a horse the cashier will issue a release form of which must be presented to the barn manager for release of the horse from barn. Buyers don't lose these release forms!
- The registration papers for all horses selling as registered will be transferred to the Buyer at the Seller's expense. The Buyer will receive the paper furnished by the Seller whether it is Canadian or American.
- All horses will be sold on the information in the footnotes, of which, were furnished by the consignor. The Sale Staff, World Clydesdale Show Committee & Auctioneer is neither responsible for any foot notes or for any warranties concerning the horse catalogue.
- The highest bidder will be the buyer. If a dispute arises between 2 or more bidders, the horse shall immediately be put up again for advance bids. If there is no advance, then the horse shall go to the person from whom the auctioneer recognized the last bid.
- Unless otherwise announced at the time of sale by the owner there is no guarantee or warranty of any kind as to the soundness or condition of any animal. THE BUYER has a responsibility to examine a horse carefully before they bid on it. If you buy a horse on impulse without inspecting it before you bid, you may expect to find some surprises. IN THAT CASE YOU STILL OWN THE HORSE! The seller & auctioneer are not responsible for you if you don't check out the horse before you buy. Once you bid on a horse you are indicating that you have checked it out enough to satisfy yourself and no one else is responsible.
