INSTRUCTIONS

1. Keep a separate record-sheet on each stallion used for breeding purposes.
2. Reports must be filed in the office of the Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. no later than January 31st of each calendar year.

- A. On or before January 31st of each year, the owner or lessee of every stallion must make a written report showing the names and registration numbers of all Clydesdale mares exposed to said stallion since the previous January. **The Stallion Report must be filed before any foals can be registered out of the Stallion.**
- B. The report also should include all breeding dates or dates of exposure.
- C. This report shall include all Clydesdale mares owned by the owner of the stallion as well as Clydesdale mares owned by other parties.
- D. The report shall be made on this official form provided by the Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. There is no fee to file this report if it is filed by January 31st. **After January 31st there will be a \$10 (\$20 for non-members) late fee to file a Stallion Report from the prior year.**

3. Demand to see the registration certificate of each Clydesdale mare exposed. This will assist you in the preparation of this report.
4. Be sure that the last recorded owner of the Clydesdale mare is the person who contracts the breeding to this stallion.
5. Give exact date(s) exposed - - if more than one service is given - be sure and show the different dates.
6. If pasture exposed - - give date the mare was turned into the pasture and date she was taken out of pasture.
7. Make sure you sign the Stallion Report and keep a copy of this report for your files and future use.

*When you artificial breed, using shipped semen, you are also required to file the Certificate of Insemination on each Clydesdale mare. If you need a copy of the rules for artificial breeding, contact the Secretary of the Association.
