



EMBRYO IMPLANTS RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The regular conditions for registry are met.
2. Has its pedigree verified by DNA test of the mare, stallion, and foal, all expense of which shall be the registration applicant's. To limit the registration of five genetic off-springs per year.
3. If embryos are frozen, the Association must be notified in writing. An inventory of frozen embryos is to be given to the Secretary by January 1st each year. If frozen embryos are sold, the Association is to be notified.
If embryo's are sold an Embryo Transfer of Ownership Form must be completed and sent to the Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. Office. Fee for filing the form prior to birth is \$20 for a member/\$40 for a non-member. If form is filed birth to June 1st the following year the fee will be \$25 for a member/\$50 for a non-member. Embryo Transfer of Ownership Forms may be obtained through the Clydesdale Office or off the website at www.clydesusa.com
4. Oocyte embryo transfer requirements to be the same as embryo transplants.
5. The suffix ET is to be added to the name when registering embryo transplants.

The Association may inspect the premises and practices of any party using or intending to use embryo transplant procedures. The burden of verify true parentage is the registration applicant's and any question of parentage shall be resolved against registration of a horse carried by a recipient mare through embryo transplant.
