### Instructions and Rules:

A. All lease agreements, correctly completed on an official lease agreement form, filed with the office of the Secretary of the Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A.

#### Complete information:

1. Registered name and number, age of pedigree, and description of horse being leased.

2. Name and address of lessee and owner(s) - printed or typed.

3. Dates of lease beginning and termination; or state "until further notice".

A lease may be terminated by recorded owner in writing to the office of the Association Secretary, and upon notification of the lessee.

4. Personal signatures of the lessee and lessor-owner on proper lines.

B. The lessee shall be considered the recorded owner of any foal born of a leased mare during period of the lease agreement or as otherwise notified by the recorded owner and lessee. Therefore it is important that consideration of the lease commencement and termination date be in accord with the subsequent ownership of resulting foal.

C. A sub-lease will be recorded by the office of the Secretary only upon the recorded owner's written recognition of sub-lease
