**SALE ORDER:** Horses will sell as they appear in the catalog.

**UNCATALOGED HORSES:** Uncataloged horses will be accepted up to April 15, 2022. Uncataloged horses must have all the required entry paperwork and will be sold after the cataloged horses. A list of uncataloged horses will be available at the Sale Office during the Sale.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions will be accepted if the required paperwork (registration and signed transfer) is submitted to and received by (not postmarked by) the Clydesdale Office by April 15, 2022. A list of substitutions will be available at the Sale Office during the Sale.

**TERMS:** All horses must be paid for in U.S. funds. Purchased horse must be paid for before or immediately at the conclusion of the National Sale on Saturday. Credit card payments (Visa or Mastercard only) will be accepted with the agreement that a 4% service charge will be added. Parties unknown to the National Clydesdale Sale Committee must bring cash, a certified check, or an irrevocable letter of credit from their bank (irrevocable letter of credit example can be obtained from the Clydesdale Office). The Auctioneer reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Transfers and pedigrees for all horses will be furnished to the Buyer, with the exception of grade horses that do not have a pedigree number appearing after their name. These horses are not papered. Sellers will pay the transfer fee. Phone bids are accepted only if pre-arranged through the Sale Office, with the client providing their own agent for conducting the phone bid procedure. Buyers exporting horses to Canada will be charged \$150 per horse for health papers. The National Clydesdale Sale Committee reserves the right to reject any horse deemed unsuitable to go through the Sale ring. ALL HORSES ENTERED IN THE NATIONAL CLYDESDALE SALE WILL GO THROUGH THE SALE RING - NO EXCEPTIONS. Registration papers will be checked against the specific animal entered in the Sale. If there is a discrepancy found on said papers, the problem must be addressed before the horse will be allowed to sell. No entry fee is required on foals selling with their dams, but completed and signed registration applications are required on those foals. A good lead strap and halter will be provided by the Seller and will go with the horse when sold. If an unacceptable halter and lead rope is left with the horse, the National Clydesdale Sale Committee will buy a new halter and lead rope and that amount will be deducted from the Consignor's check. Shoes on a horse when sold are the property of the Buyer and must not be removed or changed. Pedigrees will not be transferred until payment for horses has cleared. Returned checks will be subject to \$50 fee and buyers will have 5 days to provide payment, after which time CBUSA or Auctioneer will pursue further action.

**TACK SALE:** Tack purchased from the tack sale will be subject to the following commissions, which will be deducted from the Seller's proceeds: 20% for items <\$500; 10% for items \$500-3,000; 5% for items >\$3,000. The tax on items sold during the tack sale is 7.25% and will be charged to the Buyer. Tax exempt Buyers must present exempt certificate at the time of settlement to avoid sales tax. ALL TACK MUST BE CHECKED IN BY NOON ON THURSDAY, APRIL 22, 2022.

**BUYER REQUIREMENTS:** Buyers at the 2022 National Clydesdale Sale shall be required to be a member of either the Clydesdale Breeders of the USA, Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada, American Shire Horse Association, or Canadian Shire Horse Association. Potential Buyers who are not members of one of the listed associations shall be required to become a temporary member of the CBUSA for a fee of \$10, which includes a 1-month temporary membership with all member privileges excluding voting rights. Alternatively, lifetime memberships are also available to all non-members and will be discounted during the sale to a fee of \$100 (normal price \$200). The Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. expressly condemns and does not condone purchasing Clydesdale or Shire horses for the purpose of resale for slaughter. Buyers purchasing horses at the 2022 National Clydesdale Sale shall be required to sign an agreement stating that horses purchased at the sale shall not be resold for slaughter directly or indirectly (i.e., kill pen buyers).

**COMMISSION:** The Sale Commissions are 6% for Consignors with less than 5 horses, 5% for Consignors with 5 or more horses, but less than 10 horses, and 4% for Consignors with 10 or more horses. Commission will be deducted from Consignor's payment.

**NO SALE:** Commission on a no sale horse is the qualifying rate (per above Commission rate schedule) of the last bid. Consignor SHALL declare on the fall of the Auctioneer's gavel if the horse is to be a NO SALE.

**WARRANTIES & GUARANTEES:** Statements regarding soundness, breeding dates, etc., will be made from the auction block. Such information as breeding background, show winnings, production records of mares, and any other pertinent information is important. This information should be made available to the Sale Office at check in time and will also be used during the Mandatory Preview. The Buyer assumes full ownership of the horse with the fall of the Auctioneer's gavel and full responsibility for the care and maintenance of said horse from that point forward. No statement of warranty of the Seller can then be challenged. The Seller is responsible for their own guarantee. Each Consignor of the Sale will make what guarantee they care to give on the horses and will be totally responsible for that guarantee. These guarantees will be announced at the time the horse is placed for sale. All bred mares must be Vet Checked and certified in foal by a Veterinarian within 30 days of the Sale. Breeding information will only be announced if a National Clydesdale Sale Breeding Form is filed in the Sale Office. Mares will not be sold as being in foal if they do not have the Veterinarian Certificate. This rule will be enforced.

**LIABILITY:** Everyone is cautioned to exercise care while attending the Sale. All persons entering on the premises during the time of the Sale do so at their own risk. The Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. and all members of the National Clydesdale Sale Committee shall not be liable for any injury sustained by anyone attending the Sale. The Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A. and the National Clydesdale Sale Committee shall not be liable for any cause of action of any kind or nature arising from the sale of said horses.

**HEALTH PAPER REQUIREMENTS:** Interstate health papers and the original negative Coggins test by the laboratory must accompany the horses and are required by all States and Canada. They must be signed and dated by a licensed Veterinarian. They also must be completely filled out as far as breed, color, age, complete pedigree name of horse, etc. Please have your veterinarian fill out an interstate health paper for each individual horse. Faxed copies or photocopies are not acceptable – all Coggins papers must be the original. Coggins papers are not required on foals that are nursing and under five months of age. Foals do however need their own health paper. EACH HORSE MUST HAVE INDIVIDUAL AND UPDATED COGGINS TEST PAPERS (WITH THE BLOOD BEING DRAWN AFTER JANUARY 1, 2022). We will have a Federal Veterinarian available April 23, 2022 from 1:00-3:00 p.m. to do the paperwork on those horses that will be going to Canada. Canadian Buyers will be responsible for paying a \$150 fee for each export paper written by the Federal Veterinarian. It is imperative that your Coggins and Interstate Health papers are for export papers to be completed.

**SALE VETERINARIAN:** Equine Veterinary Service is available on-call during the sale. Dr. Kate Luthin – 217-622-7157; Dr. Karl Luthin – 217-725-4249. A Federal Veterinarian will only be present on Saturday, April 23, 2022, from 1:00-3:00 p.m. to issue health papers for horses exported to Canada.

**CANADIAN PAPERS:** Sellers of Canadian horses must submit a United States application along with the five required photos for those horses to be registered here in the United States prior to the Sale. If the horse goes back to Canada, the U.S. registration application will be void.

**ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Arrival time for horses will begin at noon on Wednesday, April 20, 2022. Horses shall be stabled by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, April 22, 2022. HORSES MUST BE CHECKED IN TO THE SALE OFFICE BY 9:00 a.m. on FRIDAY, APRIL 22, 2022. Horses must depart from the grounds by noon on Sunday, April 24, 2022. Buyers are responsible for their own transportation.

**HORSE PREVIEW:** A mandatory Sale Halter Preview will be held Friday, April 22, 2022, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The preview order will be printed in the National Clydesdale Sale Catalog with horses being grouped and presented by age. The Consignors will be responsible to get their horses to the ring at the appropriate time with no exceptions. The horses will be walked and trotted as the information from the catalog and Consignor statements are being announced.

**HITCHING/RIDING:** All horses selling as broke have the option to be driven or ridden. This is not mandatory, but the Consignors have that choice. The Consignor is responsible for making arrangements for their own equipment for such hitching. Hitching will be done Friday, April 23, 2022, at 2:00 p.m.

**STALLING, HAY, AND FEED:** Each horse shall only use one stall while at the Sale. Evan's Feed & Bedding is available for hay and shavings (\$10/bag) delivered to your stall. Please call 217-899-6001 or email [evansfeed@gmail.com](mailto:evansfeed@gmail.com) to prearrange deliveries.

**COVID-19 SALE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:** National Sale attendees shall be required to follow Covid-19 pandemic public health requirements set forth by the Illinois State Fairgrounds, Illinois Department of Agriculture, and/or Illinois Department of Public Health.
